## **Episcopal Minute: Ascension**

According to Luke in his second volume, the Acts of the Apostles, the Resurrected Christ walked on earth for forty days before finally ascending to heaven. Our liturgical calendar has taken this literally, and sure enough, forty days after Easter, we celebrate Ascension.

The opening verses of Acts state, "After his suffering he presented himself alive to them by many convincing proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God." Forty days after Easter is as variable as Easter itself. This year we had an early Easter, and thus an early Ascension Day, which falls today. May 9 (always on a Thursday).

Some of us are fond of this celebration – it can be very uplifting! – and so I transfer the observance to the following Sunday – May 12 this year, Mother's Day. All the scripture readings and music will relate to the Ascension. And we will have Bill Kendrick as our guest organist, always an uplifting experience in itself!
