- Continue developing relationships within the larger community (FISH, Lake Library, other parishes, lay preachers, Taize services, Adults with Disabilities Events)

Rev Barbara plans sabbatical

Rev Barbara is in her seventh year at New Life, a customary time for a sabbatical. Vestry approved her taking the month of May this year, for travel and enrichment. Lay preachers and supply priests will hold the fort.

Episcopal Minute: NCD

Many years ago, New Life parish engaged in a congregational development process entitled Natural Church Development (NCD). The Rev. Stephanie Pace introduced the parish to many different processes, and NCD was one of the most engaging. With this experience, Stephanie met with a group of clergy at the diocese to decide on what process the diocese would promote. Stephanie was persuasive (as were other clergy at the meeting) that NCD was a good idea. The diocese adopted it in 2007 and began a pilot program for six parishes, with New Life included. Rev. Barbara, rector of St. Paul's Canton at the time, also entered her parish into the pilot program. The result was that both New Life and Rev. Barbara know a lot about this program. And with that background, our vestry was persuaded to try it again this year, with some modifications.

At the vestry retreat on Feb. 1, Rev. Barbaa recommended that New Life focus on one aspect of the program that we really need. This aspect, Need-Oriented Evangelism, will involve whatever we think we need to improve our visibility, These improvements might include new signage, new promotional materials, improved digital presence, and newcomer response.

We will need an action team which will meet regularly (about every two weeks) to develop a strategy and make recommendations to the parish. Three members of vestry will be part of the team: Scott Bridges, Jeff Maurer and Larry Mackey. Rev. Barbara will also participate. We will need two to four additional New Life members to complete the team.

Is this something that would interest you? Can you give your energy and creativity to help the parish in this new endeavor? Please let Rev. Barbara or Senior Warden Larry Mackey know if you are interested.
