Rev Barbara is in her seventh year at New Life, a customary time for a sabbatical. Vestry approved her taking the month of May this year, for travel and enrichment. Lay preachers and supply priests will hold the fort.

Barbara plans to leave April 29 for Hamburg, Germany. The first leg of her time will three days spent with friends in Schleswig-Holstein (a region in northern Germany close to Denmark). Thereafter she will fly to Rome and spend the remainder of her time there, with emphasis on museums and archeological sites. She hopes to send "Dispatches from Rome" for the newsletter. She plans to return on May 27, and be in church on June 1, the feast of the Ascension (transferred).
