#### **Dispatch from Rome #1**

This is my second day in Rome, having spent a delightful three days in Schleswig Holstein with old friends, soaking up the charming culture of northern Germany. Kay and Eckart have lived in their thatched roof house in a rural village for over 50 years. Eckart is retired from the faculty of Kiel University, where he had a long career as a professor of geography. He and his American wife Kay love the country living. They have two German/American sons, one adopted Korean daughter, and grandchildren from all three in a mixture of ethnicities. Mostly we sat around and talked for three days. Eckart loved telling their neighbors that Kay and I grew up as neighbors and played dolls together as children. I fell back easily into speaking German, but having arrived in Rome, I am trying to switch gears into Italian, which I barely speak at all.

Fortunately, my hosts in Rome are fluent in Italian. Michael is British/American, a professor of anthropology, retired from Harvard (and believe me, he has plenty to say about Harvard's current political struggles!) His wife Nea was my college roommate. I am so fortunate to have such interesting friends!

On Tuesday all of us are leaving Rome. Nea and Michael are going north to Milan, where Michael is delivering lectures for a week. I am heading south to the Amalfi Coast, based in Sorrento, to enjoy the beautiful scenery and visit two archeological sites (Pompeii and Paestum) before returning to Rome on Saturday. I have a date to meet Larry Mackey on Sunday at the Episcopal church, St Paul's within the Walls. I will write about all that in Dispatch #2 next week.

Meanwhile, please know that I miss all of you, but I am truly enjoying my time away.
