Episcopal Minute: Pentecost

This Sunday Easter season ends and Pentecost begins. We will usher in Pentecost with an imaginative liturgy including Enriching Our Worship and prayers from liturgist Ruth Duck. The Holy Spirit kite, in the shape of a dove, will fly over our heads. Valerie Thorson will bring us beautiful organ music. Be sure to join us! (and wear red).

Pentecost season is sometimes called Ordinary Time. These six months give us opportunities to contemplate the sacred seasons just completed. We will continue our Gospel readings in Luke, including his famous parable of the Good Samaritan July 13 (when our guest preacher will be Debbie Likins-Fowler). We will single out two feast days: June 29 Sait Peter and Saint Paul – Saint Peter is one of our patron saints. (The other is Saint Michael, who we will celebrate on September 29). We will also pay tribute to Saint Mary the Virgin on **August 17**, the Sunday closest to her feast day August 15.

Deacon's Dismissal

by Rev Josh Butler A letter to Nick: "Yes, I am still a deacon! They've not yet defrocked me. And yes, twelve years on, I still write those weekly Dismissals. They all have one thing in common, though my Muse forbids me say what it is. I call them "Dismissals" because, when the Sunday service ends, the deacon dismisses the people: 'Go in peace to love and serve the Lord!' (or some other dismissal, page 366, **Book of Common Prayer). To write** these little stories is a delight whenever the Muse deigns to visit ... though often enough, I am left to my own devices."
